- SHIRTS WITH COLLARS - BLACK TIE
1. Taking into consideration black ties already issued to units for leave personnel, an automatic issue of one tie per OR is now being made to all units on the basis of their approx OR str. Although stocks do not permit a similar gen issue of shirts with collars, this item has been up during the past few months so that all units should now have sufficient to outfit leave personnel.
2. The wearing of black ties will be governed by the provisions of Cdn RO (21 a 4) 700 and ORD 5275 wef 18 Mar 45.
3. When the tie is not worn, the blouse will be buttoned up to the top. During the summer months, i.e. 1 May to 30 Sep, on occasions when the tie is not authorized for wear, the hooks and top button only of the buttonless blouse may, except on ceremonial parades, be left unfastened at the discretion of the OC.

- VISITS TO OFFICERS' CLUB
Officers are permitted to travel to OSTERED for the purpose of visiting the club.

- FOREIGN CURRENCY
All foreign currency notes and bank cheques will be handed into the bank on Monday 19 Mar 45. After that date no further exchange will be permitted. It is illegal to have a large amount of foreign currency notes and cheques.
